- 2020 Obvious theme you'll probably hear this everywhere "A year of vision" – focus – clarity – "2020 vision" Actually started preparing messages

But when I prayed I sensed something different...

I think there's a desperate need for the power of God I think people need Holy Spirit encounters I think people want more than religion – they need miracles I think they want more than a belief system I think people want a presence-filled Christianity

We've flooded the church world with preaching – information We're in information overload – Instagram – YouTube People aren't looking for information They're looking for transformation

Even lost people know ABOUT God

They're looking for an experience WITH God Information is everywhere – Transformation is scarce

I heard the Holy Spirit say...

People shouldn't come to church looking for God and only find us.

A year where we will do everything to make room for a move of God A year where we believe God for more

Nothing weird or man-made But if God is real – if God is alive We need encounters with Him – never the same

The Christmas Story

What does that have to do with Christmas?

Actually a lot – my favorite part of the Christmas story

(Matthew 1:18-21) This is how the birth of Jesus the Messiah came about: His mother Mary was pledged to be married to Joseph, but before they came together, she was found to be pregnant through the Holy Spirit. Because Joseph her husband was faithful to the law, and yet did not want to expose her to public disgrace, he had in mind to divorce her quietly. But after he had considered this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, "Joseph son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife, because what is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins." Makes sense – because Jesus means "God saves" It was a common name – not unique Even today – still used Joke – Mexican restaurant – Jesus – thank you Jesus

And most people know Him as Savior But He's more than a Savior

(Matthew 1:23) The virgin will be with child and will give birth to a son, and <u>they will call him Immanuel</u> --which means, "God with us."

His Name is Jesus – But they will call Him something else Sort of like a nickname I love nicknames – endears you to the person a bit more Describes the person a little better

His Name is Jesus – but they will call Him – Immanuel Why did would they call Him that? God with us is so different – never had that before

Different from the religion they grew up with

OT vs. NT - external vs. internal - heaven vs. earth

God knew we needed more than the external – far away God We needed Someone to be with us

Christmas is all about the greatest gift ever More than a Savior – God with us

He continues to be with us – through the Holy Spirit

(John 14:16-17 NLT) And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate, who will never leave you. He is the Holy Spirit, who leads into all truth. The world cannot receive him, because it isn't looking for him and doesn't recognize him. But you know him, because he lives <u>with you</u> now and later will be <u>in you</u>.

Question: You might know His mission – Savior But do you know the Man – God with us?

Story – my testimony – Christmas 1978 More than religion – it was an encounter with God

God With Us

"God with us" is one of the best parts of being a Christian I rely on it so much in ministry Some of you here today need to experience God's presence That's our prayer

1. For when we're afraid - sad - confused

Watched the presence of God make all of the difference

Story - Jess Johnson - others who are missing someone

2. For when you feel helpless on your own

Battling disease - addiction

Story – freedom

3. For when you're not sure about God

I think some are still skeptical – not sure What makes us different from any other faith? How do you know if it's really real?

In all of my reading and study of the Bible I have never found any person in the Scriptures Who came to God because of a great explanation

Those who were convinced had a power encounter They never questioned God – instead wouldn't back down

(1 John 4:13 NLT) And God has given us his Spirit as proof that we live in him and he in us.
